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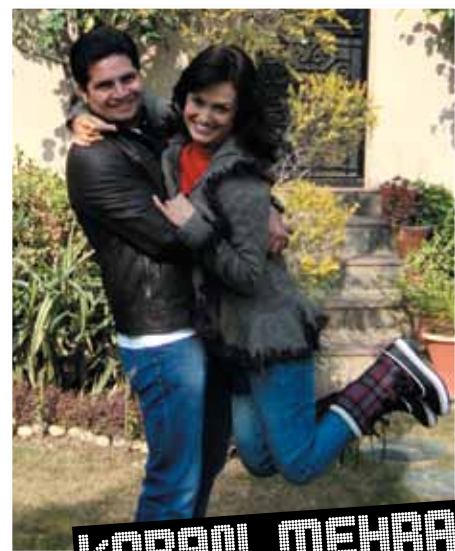
Want to know what your favourite celebrities will be wearing this Valentine's Day? StyleSpeak finds out for you.

AISHWARYA SAKHUJA

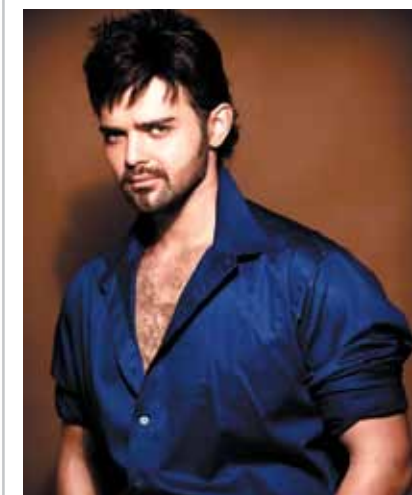
